



PRIVACY AND COOKIES

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your device so that a website can remember information about your visit. A cookie will typically contain the name of the website that created it, a time period for which it is valid, and a value, which is often a randomly generated and unique number.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

To improve our service we collect anonymous web and search statistics using a programme called Google Analytics. They store several cookies on users' computers or mobile devices to tell us how many people have visited each web page, how they got there, and where they navigated to from there. The data collected is completely anonymous and does not store any personal details.

BELOW IS A LIST OF COOKIES WE USE:

Cookie	Type	Description
._ga	Analytics	This cookie is installed by Google Analytics. The cookie is used to calculate visitor, session, campaign data and keep track of site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookies store information anonymously and assign a randomly generated number to identify unique visitors.
._ga	Analytics	This cookie is installed by Google Analytics. The cookie is used to store information of how visitors use a website and helps in creating an analytics report of how the website is doing. The data collected including the number visitors, the source where they have come from, and the pages visited in an anonymous form.

THIRD PARTY COOKIES

Some third party services embedded within this website set their own cookies. These are known as third party cookies because they are not set by our website. We have no control over third party cookies.

HOW CAN I TURN OFF OR CONTROL COOKIES?
